Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 28 of the Punjab Shops and Commercial Establishments Act, 1958 (Punjab Act 15 of 1958) and all other enabling powers, the Governor of Haryana hereby fixes "schedule mentioned in the above table" to be the **holiday with wages** for all Shops and Commercial Establishments falling within the jurisdiction area of the State of Haryana for only those employees who are enrolled as voters in the above mentioned States/UTs to enable them to cast their votes.

Whereas, the Governor of Haryana is satisfied that the exemption is required to enable the adult workers, working in the factories situated in the State of Haryana to exercise their franchise in the General Election to the Lok-Sabha, 2024 or the Legislative Assembly of the State as per the schedule announced by the Election Commission of India.

And whereas, it has been considered necessary to provide opportunity to the public to exercise their franchise.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 65 of the Factories Act, 1948 (Central Act 63 of 1948) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Haryana is pleased to exempt all the adult workers working in the factories situated in the State of Haryana who are the voters of the State as mentioned below in the table and are entitled to vote at an election to Lok-Sabha or the Legislative Assembly of the State, on the day of polling of respective State from the operations of provision of sub-section (1) of section 52 of the said Act for the weeks as mentioned in the below table subject to the condition that no adult worker who is enrolled as the voters of that respective States shall be required or allowed to work on the polling day of respective State, in the State of Haryana.


